If you arrive in Paris at the Charles De Gaulle airport, take the bus 95.18 (the schedule can be found on the [web page of the summer school](#)) to *Cergy-Prefecture* (final stop). Then take a train RER A to *Neuville-Université* (next stop in the direction to Paris). The residence is about 5-10 minute walk from the railway station; the map can be found on the [web page](#). Alternatively, you can get to *Neuville-Université* from Paris by taking RER A in the direction to *Cergy-le-Haut*.

Participants staying at the hotels *Formule 1* and *Campanile* should arrive to RER A station *Cergy-Prefecture* (either by bus or by train) and follow the instructions mentioned in the section below. The hotels are located next to the university building, on the other side of the road.

Directions to the University of Cergy-Pontoise

The summer school will take place at the mathematics department, which is located at 5th floor of Building E, Campus *Saint Martin*. The building is typically about 15 minute walk from the RER station *Cergy-Prefecture*. Leaving the station, take the left exit and follow a marked path, leading to the city centre. Do not take the stairs at the end of the path on your left (direction "Centre Ville"), but walk along *Boulevard de l'Oise* for about 200m. At the crossing turn right to *Boulevard du Port* and walk for about 500m, crossing the highway A15. On the right-hand side, you should see a modern university building *Sciences et Techniques*. Enter it through the main entrance and take one of the two elevators on your left.
